Garbage Waste

Note: As of July 1, 2006 garbage will be collected bi-weekly with a limit of 4 bags.



Remember to Use Bag Tags for More than 4 Bags!



Collected <u>bi-weekly</u> on your regular collection day. Check the maps on page 4 & 5. Just follow the calendar colour for your area to determine your waste collection day of the week.

Garbage bags or reusable containers with contents cannot weigh more than 20 kg (44 lbs) each. Garbage bags that break when lifted will not be collected.

See photo on back cover for proper set out along the curb.

There is a limit of **4** untagged bags or containers of garbage per household every **two weeks**. A standard size garbage bag or garbage can counts as one bag.

Residents setting out more than 4 bags of garbage every two weeks are required to tag each bag over the 4 bag limit. Tags are \$1.50 each and are to be flagged around the top of garbage bag. See page 13 for locations to purchase Bag Tags.

Residential waste should be set out for curbside collection **before 7:00 a.m.** on the day of waste collection.

Recyclables, compostables and household hazardous waste are **not** to be mixed in with your garbage.
