

Large Bulky Items



Large bulky items such as home appliances, household furniture or household items too big to fit into a garbage can or garbage bag will be collected bi-weekly on your regular waste collection day.

There is a limit of two items per collection.

Place wastes along the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day. Household appliances may contain chlorofluorocarbons (CFC's). Residents are encouraged to take extra care when placing these items at the curb to ensure that CFC's are not released into the air.

Refrigerator and freezer doors must be completely removed by resident before these items can be safely placed out along the curb for collection. Let's play it safe.

Unacceptable Items

Wastes not acceptable for curbside collection

- Material longer than 3 feet in any direction or weighing more than 20 kg (44 lbs)
- Material in excess of the bi-weekly garbage limit and not tagged for collection
- Any material frozen to a returnable container and not easily removed by shaking
- Any material set out for waste collection located on private property
- Household Hazardous Wastes such as propane tanks, oil and filters, explosives or highly combustible liquids or materials, pesticides, pool chemicals, fertilizers, paints, varnishes, batteries etc.
- Construction/demolition/renovation materials such as flooring (ceramic, vinyl, hardwood), drywall, lumber, fences, bricks, decks, sheds, asphalt, siding, concrete, shingles
- Trees or brush more than 75 mm diameter (3 inches)
- Animal waste or carcasses, excluding kitchen wastes
- Hospital, medical or radioactive wastes
- Agricultural or farm wastes
- Automotive parts and accessories including tires
- Hot ashes or any waste capable of starting a fire
- Manufacturing, industrial, commercial or institutional wastes
