Illegal Dumping

Roadside Dumping Costs Us All

Roadside dumping is illegal. Tax dollars badly needed for other programs pay for the clean up and proper disposal of these wastes.

Witnesses to roadside dumping should record the following information and report it to the City of Pickering Municipal Law Enforcement Services at 905-420-4611

- Licence plate number
- Colour and type of vehicle
- Location, time and date
- Description of dumped wastes
- Description of dumping offender

Local municipal by-laws and provincial environmental protection laws apply to anyone who dumps waste materials illegally.
